
TCCA is accepting membership applications. TCCA Membership period is from January through December and must be renewed annually to stay in good standing with the Association.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Any person serving in a non-judicial, nonvendor capacity as Court Clerk, Administrator, or in any other capacity within the framework of Municipal Court or Justice of the Peace Court, serving on a full-time or part-time basis, is eligible for membership upon paying the dues as provided for herein.

TCCA Membership period is from January through December and must be renewed annually to stay in good standing with the Association.

CERTIFICATION **PROGRAM**

In 1996, TCCA partnered with the Texas Municipal Court Education Center, Texas Municipal Courts Association and Texas State University to create an educational development program. The Municipal Court Clerk Certification Program was developed to provide professional development and educational growth to Court staff in Municipal and Justice Courts.

The program is comprised of three levels. Participants may achieve certification upon successful completion of each of the three levels earning the titles of Certified Court Clerk I, Certified Court Clerk II and Certified Municipal Court Clerk.

HISTORY

The Texas Court Clerks Association (TCCA) was founded on March 14, 1972 by and for Municipal and Justice Court Clerks. Our mission is to provide members with a source of quality judicial education essential to establishing the highest level of professional stan-

dards and maintaining public confidence.

Each year, TCCA holds

featuring quality educational sessions and a vendor exhibit. The first conference was held in September 1972 at the Rice Hotel in Houston, with 34 clerks from across the State attending,

TCCA currently has nearly 1,000 clerks participating statewide and consists of eight chapters (Central Texas, Freedom Trail, Gulf Coast, North Texas, Northeast Texas, Panhandle, South Texas and West Texas).
